It's super simple and pretty easy, and by the way, this is the first set of instructions on the web on how to make one of these. You need what you need. -block wood bass-copper wire-foam-knife -a dremel-gold spray paint -A DS game case or other plastic of your choice -small nail-tin clippers-super glue-back pin that you wear In preparation soon to come cinema I started looking for a web to find how to make a mocking mocking pin and everything that came up were pictures and print so I made my share. :D P.S. Don't be afraid to post pictures of the pins you make if you make one! The first thing that was going to do was a bird in the center of the pin. Start by separating the block of wood to thick as you want it. (photo1) Then take a print out to cut the bird and trace to the tree (photo 2-4) Now get your dremel ready and cut the shape of the bird. (photo 5) What I did next, which is an optional ribbon picture of the actual bird on my neckline and used a detail bit, a hand knife and a dander bit to make the wings look separate and make the head look better. (photo 6-7) Now we have to work in the ring. What I did was take the old DS game case and cut a circle out of it, but you can use any other thick plastic. (photo 1-2) Then sand down in a circle where it's smooth It's a pretty complicated part of the build. Use copper wire and cut into length arrows in the photo you printed earlier. (photo1) Yours is probably wondering what's going on about the arrow of the head and feathers. Well I have the answer ... WE'RE USING FOAM! Okay, enough with a cry, cut the foam to the size Want your arrow's head and feathers to be. (photo 2-4) Then shove the arrow head on the end of the length of the wire and glue on on Feathers. (photo 5) There are two options on how to get it to stay on your shirt. You can 1.use magnets, glue one to the back of your bird and put the other behind your shirt and connect them or 2. As I cut the nail with the tin scissors, drill a small hole and shove the nail into the hole, then glue it in place, let it dry and use the back of the other pin to connect it through the shirtThe bird glue to the ring. The second glue arrows to the birds mouth and tail. (Look at the photo you printed) REALLY!!!!!! For the last step spray paint the pin of gold. And most importantly have fun with him!
