Psychological thriller is the most successful novel by the author and in 2003 was published in Spanish in Spain, Chile, Argentina, Colombia, Venezuela, Mexico, Uruguay and Ecuador, where it remained among the bestsellers. The story, which tests the ability of the main character to prevent suicide in the face of pressure from a stranger, stands out psychological realism of their characters and the ability to create an intriguing plot. Argument Part One: The Threatening Letter by Dr. Frederick Ricky Starks is an American psychoanalytic with a long career behind him. On the day of his 53rd anniversary, he receives a letter from a psychopath who signs as Rumpelstiltskin and who apparently carries the knowledge of his normal life. All he knows is that the reason for such threats is revenge for some past event that Ricky does not remember. When he decides to contact those relatives who appear as potential victims with whom he has been out of business for years, Ricky discovers that the teenage daughter of one of his nephews received threats in his high school locker where he found pornographic photos showing threatening writings. As if that wasn't enough, she gets a visit from an attractive woman who calls it Hess Virgil and who is an assistant to Rumpelstiltskin. He tells her that his boss sent him to play Virgil and lead him to hell. Ricky kicks him out of the office, still thinking about what to do: seriously treat the psycho-terror threat or not. But there are events that make him fear for his life. First, the apparent suicide of Roger Zimmermann, one of his patients, jumping into subway tracks and leaving a suicide note accusing him of being psychoanalytic, second, that a former patient filed a complaint with a psychoanalytic school accusing Dr. Frederick Starks of raping her during her sessions. Third, they canceled all your bank accounts on your behalf and bankrupted you. Doctor. Starks by all means trying to reveal the identity of his formidable. After a series of events that threaten and at the same time confuse Ricky, rambling in time, and almost late in term putting Rumpelstiltskin, Ricky Starks discovers that Mr. R is one of Claire Tyson's three children, the former patient he had when he worked at the clinic 20 years ago before setting up his own private practice and turning to caring for people who had the financial means To take sessions; this patient was cared for for 4 sessions (out of 5). He never took the 5th session, something about Ricky went unnoticed, 15 days after he treated her, a woman committed suicide when Rumpelstiltskin was just a child. Now Mr. R. has turned into a powerful adult, decides to avenge the death of his mother, believing that, not supporting his mother, they destroyed his life, bringing her to suicide, so that she began a long journey of destruction of the lives of all those who once turned away from her. Dr. Starks is another victim of master revenge. The life of Dr. Starks is completely destroyed: his bank accounts are desperately stolen, his career is covered with a false scandal of sexual abuse of a patient and his house destroyed. It's completely alone in a fast-paced game. The game involves two characters who, without directing him, seem to confuse him and take him away from the goal of the game. This is Virgil, Ricky's guide to hell. This woman makes continuous visits to Dr. Starks to review her progress and give clues. The second character is Merlin, the so-called patient's lawyer, who accuses Starks of sexual assault. Ricky seeks help from Dr. Lewis, his former mentor. The old man manages to direct him to the correct course of his investigation, but mysteriously disappears the next day. Ricky, despite significant progress in his investigation, the days are over and he can't find Mr R's name until the deadline, so he is forced to stage his death by setting his summer house on fire and drowning at sea. It shows a man who is already structuring his own world and loses everything, at the end of this desolation makes him come not only to think, but to feel that his own existence is also over. Part Two: The Man Who Never Existed In this second part of the novel, Ricky Starks makes every last mark of himself disappearing. Part 3: Even bad poets love death begins the moment Rumpelstiltskin discovers that Ricky Starks is still alive. Dr. Starks takes the name of Frederick Lazarus, the man who rose from the dead, and sends a clear message to Rumpelstiltskin: The game has started again. In this part of the book, Ricky manages to reveal the true identity of all the participants in the game. Through great feats and meticulous research, Ricky discovers that Dr. Lewis, his former mentor, was a great master of the plan that led him to his own death, contributing to the formation of Rumpelstiltskin.He also discovers that Virgil is an actress/model, and that Merlin is a successful lawyer, and that they are both brothers of Rumpelstiltskin. Using his new identity, he manages to threaten Merlin and Virgil to death, causing rage Rumpelstiltskin. Rumpelstiltschen goes on the hunt for Ricky after a false version, arranged by Ricky himself, that is, he is ambushed. The final meeting is patiently held upon the arrival of Rumpelstiltskin.
